


Base Kit – Old Nichimo No-02 with extensive interior and exterior alterations

- New Interior with floor, central tunnel, new seats, seat belts, rear lateral panels and without rear seats;
- A Terratrip or tripmaster in the dashboard at co-pilot side (decal 7);
- Complete rollbar as shown;
- All air intakes opened;
- New exhaust pan and pipe:
- New wheels and tyres;
- Repositioned side mirror
- New petrol cap in the rear right panel, at the base of the air intake;
- Etc, etc


Overall blue with false bumpers, motor cover and front aileron in black. The NACA air intakes in the hood, here marked in grey, are body colour.









For Heller 80700, L760, HE80700, Heller Humbrol 80754, Wave MHD-84 or Union MC-11, MC-75

- Construction without rear bumper and using only the front section of front bumper
- Only central rollbar
- Two additional front headlamps
- 3-point seatbelts

Consider to use the Renaissance transkit TK24-334, not using the rear arm of rollbar, and TK24-325 PE parts.



Base kit - Tamiya 24130 or 24048 (better)

- Yellow body, with all the chrome parts in black;
- Four extra spot lights on the front bumper and one rectangular back light;
- Conversion for left hand drive;
- The "roll bar" is only over the pilot (see picture).
