

# **ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS**

## **(1) IMPORTANT INFORMATIONS**

- The kit is made by 3D print resins.
- Don't use Resin Wash.
- Thin resin parts are easy to deform. Carefully adjust with a hair dryer or hot water at 60°C or higher. Don't boil resin parts.
- Don't immerse in water, hot water, or solvents for a long time. Absorbs water and solvents.
- After washing with water, dry completely.
- Smooth the parts by sand papers and nippers.
- Various type of putty are available.
- Use epoxy or CA glue only.
- Please try temporarily assembly the kit before applying any adhesives.
- Recommend to apply primer surfacer before painting.
- Decals are not pre-cutted. They must be cut individually.
- Don't rub the decals to much, it's easy to scratch.
- If you use any decal softer or setter practice at a not needed decal piece.

#### **A** CAUTION

- Read carefully and fully understand all instructions before assembly.
- Extra care should be taken whenn using tools avoid personal injury.
- When using paint and cement (not included) read and follow their nstructions.
- Assemble the kit away from the reach of chirldren.
- Keep all parts and vinyl bags away from children.
- Model car for collectors. Not suitable foe under 18 years old.







### DECAL GUIDE











For 1 and 36 use optional decals to select the different drivers (34-Moreno / 35-McCarthy). Use 25 or 27 for shoulder pads of seat belts.

Check for 36 regarding left and right side position.




The decals are made by digital technology. Decals work the same way as other water slide decals.


The cover lacquer is on the entire surface of the sheet, so it's necessary to first cut each print off the sheet with a small overlap. Then immerse the decal in warm water and place it


on a non-absorbent surface with the underlying paper down. Leave the printout off until it's easy to move on the underlying paper. Use a soft brush to place the decal on the desired location on the model. Clean the excess water ith a clean cloth or paper towel and gently squeeze the print over the surface.


The decals react normally to products of the "Set" and "Sol" type. Even though, recommend to try them first.













Repeat the assembly for the right side in mirror image. Use part #3 and P8.

It is recommended to use fine sandpaper and polishing paste to polish the mirror surfaces.














Assemble the pieces in the listed order, left to right, top to bottom.

It is not necessary to glue R1.


Repeat the assembly for the right side in mirror image.
Use parts #25/26/R1/27/28/29.





Make sure to attach the brake line downwards.












Repeat the assembly for the right side in mirror image.


A hole of Ø0.9mm is recommended for the screws. Therefore, drill out the holes in the hubs.
