


The 1976 US Grand Prix at Long Beach was the 16th and last Formula 1 Grand Prix contested by Vel's Parnelli Jones Racing. Unfortunately Mario Andretti had to retire from the race due to a water leak.


After the radical body changes seen at the South African Grand Prix, in sillhouette it again resembled the late 1975 car. The side radiators and nose cone remained the same as in South Africa, but now the 1975 red cockpit surround and air box were blue in the colours of sponsor, American Racing Wheels.


As in South Africa the longer wheel base remained and dampers with coil springs were used all round.


Suspension was upper and lower links with torsion bars at the rear and double wishbone with torsion bars at the front. The brakes were inboard at the rear and outboard at the front.












